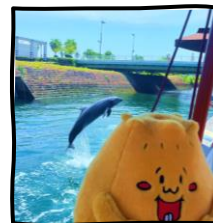

## How do I dispose of volcanic ash?

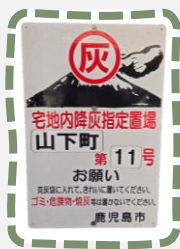
Ash collection bags are needed for disposal.

Gather the ash in the bag, tie it at the top, and place it at the designated ash collection

spot in your area. (You can also put the ash in two layered plastic bags if you don't have the ash collection bag.)

The minimum amount distributed is one bundle of ten bags.

### Sri Lanka Kagoshima & Parindaya

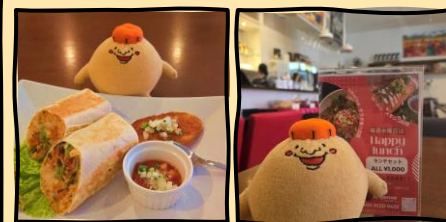
